If the charger ring terminals, alligator clips, or quick-connect terminals are corroded or damaged or not making full electrical contact, or the battery posts are corroded, then: Disconnect charger cables from battery and clean the battery posts and the charger ring terminals, alligator clips.



Another possible cause for the blinking amber LED is incorrect connection of the output alligator clips or ring terminals. If these connections are not properly attached to the battery, the charger may not be able to detect the battery or deliver the charge effectively. So, it's worth. Also, if the green light keeps flashing while the red light stays on, it indicates that the battery is more than 80% charged and is ready to use. How do I know if my Battery Tender is working?

To test if your Battery Tender is working, follow these steps: Plug your Battery Tender into an outlet. Connect the alligator clips to your battery terminals. Check the Battery Tender's LED light status. What do the lights mean on my Battery Tender?

Why does my battery tender keep flashing?



If the green light on the battery tender keeps flashing and never turns solid green, it may indicate that the battery is charging, but the charger is not drawing enough power from the power source. This usually happens for various reasons, including faulty outlets, wiring, and loose connection.

How many volts does a battery read before attaching a tender?

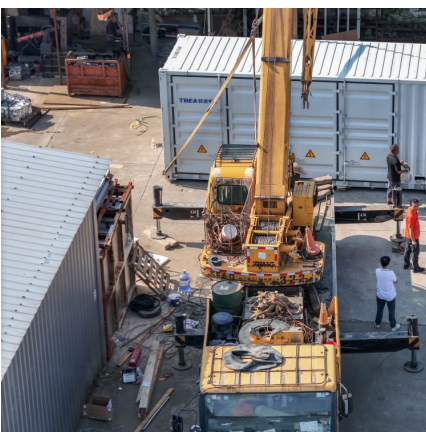
