

Enterprise ESS system project financing options in Tanzania 2025





Overview

This will be done through funding of an Apex non-bank financial institution (NBFi, a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV), which will be established under the project to provide wholesale financing to banks and, Microfinance Institutions (MFIs), regulated NBFIs referred to as Project Financial Institutions (PFIs) that will in turn extend financing to SMEs and innovative start-ups. How much will Tanzania invest in TIC in 2025?

The government of Tanzania has announced an ambitious plan to attract US\$ 15 billion (approximately TZS 38 trillion) worth of investments through the Tanzania Investment Centre (TIC) in 2025, building on its record-breaking achievements in 2024.

What will Tanzania do in 2025?

Tanzania aims to attract US\$ 15 billion in investments in 2025, prioritizing manufacturing, clean energy, transport, minerals, agriculture, and services. The government plans key reforms, including merging TIC and EPZA, enhancing infrastructure, and simplifying investment processes through the One-Stop Facilitation Centre.

What is the Tanzania Finance Act 2025?

The Finance Act, 2025, aligns with the TZS 56 trillion budget to drive Tanzania's economic development by incentivizing agriculture (TZS 7 trillion GDP boost over three years), industry (TZS 725 billion in 2025), and revenue collection (TZS 162 billion from informal sector).

How will Tanzania's new tax law affect TZS?

With GDP growth projected at 5.5% for 2025 (Bank of Tanzania estimate), the Act introduces measures like a three-year VAT exemption on fertilizers, saving TZS 1.8 billion annually for a TZS 10 billion firm, and a 75% customs duty relief on capital goods, reducing costs by TZS 187.5 million per TZS 1 billion import.



Why is investment rising in Tanzania?

“The sustained upward trend in investment reflects the growing strength of Tanzania’s economy,” he noted. The minister highlighted key reforms under the Sixth Phase Government, including the enactment of the Investment Act of 2022 and enhanced investment promotion campaigns domestically and internationally.

How resilient is Tanzania's economy?

Despite negative economic growth trends globally, as well as within the SADC and EAC regions over the past three years, Tanzania's economy demonstrated resilience. The national Gross Domestic Product (GDP) increased to TZS 156.6 trillion in 2024, up from TZS 148.5 trillion in 2023.

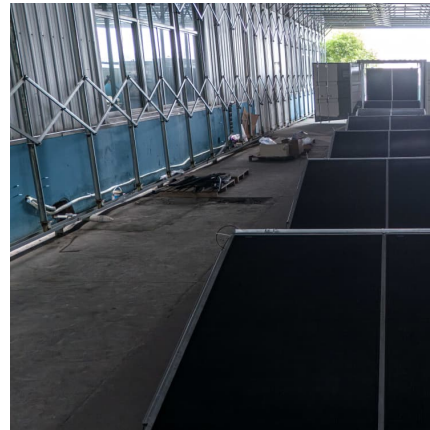

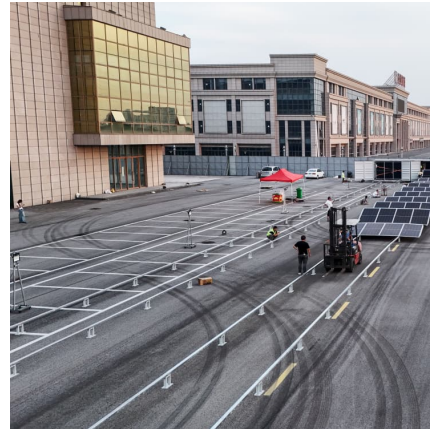
